New Recycling Bins - Within the next month or two, the village is going to switch over to wheeled, recycling CARTS with automated recyclable pick-up. Advanced Disposal will provide one (1) ninety-five (95) gallon wheeled CART, per unit for residential recyclables. The CARTS will be provided at NO CHARGE to the Village or the customer. However, in the event of loss, theft or negligence, Advanced Disposal shall charge sixty-five dollars (\$65) for replacement of the cart. This cost will be handed down to the customer. After the carts are delivered, WASTE & RECYCLING PICK-UP will still take place on Tuesdays, but RECYCLING PICK-UP **ONLY** will change to EVERY OTHER WEEK. A pick-up schedule will be attached to the carts upon delivery Please keep the schedule for future reference. We will provide you with updated information as it becomes available, so please keep an eye on the posting board in front of the Village Hall & on the Village websites.

Village of Theresa Regulation of Length of Lawn and Grasses - Village Ordinance Section 127-3

<u>Purpose:</u> This section is adopted due to the unique nature of the problems associated with lawns, grasses & noxious weeds being allowed to grow to excessive length in the Village of Theresa

<u>Public Nuisance:</u> The Village of Theresa finds that lawns, grasses & noxious weeds on nonagricultural lots or parcels of land, which exceed six (6) inches in length, adversely affect the public health & safety of the public. For that reason, any nonagricultural lawn, grass or weed on a lot or other parcel of land, which exceed six (6) inches in length, will hereby be considered a public nuisance.

<u>Inspection:</u> The Weed Commissioner or his designee shall inspect or cause to be inspected all premises & places within the Village to determine whether any public nuisance exists. The Weed Commissioner shall immediately cause a five-day written notice to be served that the Village proposes to have the weeds or lawn cut so as to conform with this section. Only one notice, per year, shall be served upon the owner or occupant.

Grass Reminder

It is unlawful to blow your grass clippings & leaves into the street. Grass clippings clog up sewer grates & prevent proper drainage during heavy rainstorms. Violators may be fined!

The Theresa Sewer & Water Utility Department would appreciate it if you would write your account number on the memo line of your check when making a utility payment. Thank you for your cooperation!

If you're contemplating filling your swimming pool and are interested in receiving a SEWER credit. We need to receive your request in writing. Write down your sewer & water utility meter reading before you fill & after you fill your pool. Drop off the meter reading numbers, along with your name, address & utility account number at the Village Hall, or place it in the "payment" box located next to the door at the Village Hall.

BULK PICK-UP

- The Village holds two Bulk Pick-ups per year, one on the third Tuesday in April (4/17/2018) & one on the third Tuesday in October (10/16/2018). Bulk items & tires will be collected curbside right along with the regular garbage & recycling pick-up.
- There will be a fee associated with the bulk pick-up of tires & appliances. Bills will be sent after pick-up as required.
- If you have questions on what items will be collected, please contact Advanced Disposal Services @ (920) 387-0987.
- The Village can no longer accept electronics. These items can/should be reused or donated. For more information on e-cycling & where to recycle electronics, visit www.dnr.wi.gov/ecyclewisconsin. Click "Find" for electronics collection sites nearby.
- Building materials are NOT accepted as part of Bulk Pick-Up. Please contact Advanced Disposal Services @ (920) 387-0987 for dumpster rental.
- Garbage bags laying on the ground or near the waste cart will NOT be picked up unless they are placed in the green waste cart.
- Cardboard boxes must be broken down & placed in or near the recycling bin.
- Yard waste will NOT be accepted & should be disposed of at the yard waste/brush site located at River's Edge Park from April through November (weather permitting). Please follow all rules & regulations at drop-off site.
- Please place all items on the curb in an orderly fashion.

DO NOT PUT ITEMS ON THE CURB PRIOR TO THE WEEKEND BEFORE BULK PICK-UP!

🔻 YARD WASTE 🐚

Leaves, lawn clippings, branches, etc. are not picked up during bulk pick-up or with the regular weekly pick-up. Yard waste disposal site is located behind River's Edge Park. Brush goes on the brush pile. Lawn clippings, leaves, small plants and garden waste go on the yard waste pile. Please take your containers and bags with you. No timbers or landscaping edging allowed. No other items other than yard waste are to be dumped at this site! Dumping of garbage, furniture, carpeting, building material and/or any other non-yard waste items is prohibited!

VILOATORS WILL BE SUBJECT TO FINES AND FOREITURES!

Building Permits

If you're contemplating a remodeling, shed, fence, deck or any other construction project, be sure to check with the Building Inspector to find out what zoning requirements apply and/or to purchase a building permit. The Inspector (Doc) can be reached by calling (262)-364-9597. Zoning & building codes & printable building permit application can be found on the Village website www.villageoftheresa.com. Failure to obtain a building permit in timely manner could result in double fees being assessed!

OPEN BURNING

Per Village Ordinance 5-2-9, no person, firm or corporation shall build any outdoor fire within the Village limits.

This prohibition includes burning of GARBAGE, YARD WASTE & CONSTRUCTION WASTE.

Exceptions to this section include ceremonial campfires, or outdoor cooking in/or over a fire contained in a device or structure approved by

PET INFORMATION

All dogs & cats 6 months or older must be licensed by April 1st of every year. Proof of spaying/neutering & rabies vaccination is required. The cost of the license is \$15 for males/females & \$10 for spayed or neutered animals. There is now a pet licensing application form on the Forms page of the Village of Theresa website.

Be a polite pet owner by picking up all solid feces from any street, sidewalk, alley or private or public property. Violators will be subject to fines & forfeiture.

No person having ownership or possession of any animal shall allow the animal to run at large in the Village. For more information visit the Village website at www.villageoftheresa.com.

Theresa Fire Department News-submitted by Ryan Koll & Andy Wolf

The Theresa Fire Department responded to 85 calls in 2017 which is a 50% increase over 2016. The department also logged 5417.8 hours of in-house & outside training & maintenance activities in 2017. Currently, all active firefighters are state certified & many of our members have additional certifications which aren't required by the state. As of 2017, our fire department entered into an automatic mutual-aid agreement with the Lomira Fire Department, Knowles Fire Department & the Kekoskee Fire Department, which means that when those departments get called out, we automatically respond to their calls as well.

The Theresa Fire Department applied in three previous years to get a grant for a new 4,000-gallon water tanker truck. In 2017, the fire department was informed by FEMA that we were successful in procuring a FEMA grant in the amount of \$332,000! The department is responsible to match 5% or \$16,000 as part of the program. The chassis arrived in late March & delivery of the completed unit is expected by late summer 2018. Since 2002, the department has written for & received, three FEMA grants; saving local taxpayers a total of \$610,616.

IN AN EMERGECNY CALL 911! We also ask that you contact Advanced Disposal directly by calling customer service at (920) 387-0949 with questions or concerns pertaining to waste and recycling pick up. SECURE PAYMENT DROP BOX - Normal business hours for the Clerk-Treasurer's Office are: Monday thru Thursday, 8am-4pm & on Friday from 8am-Noon, these hours are subject to change & will be posted accordingly. For your convenience, the village has a **SECURE PAYMENT DROP BOX** located outside the door of the Village Hall at 202 S. Milwaukee Street. This box can be for used ALL village & utility correspondence including, but not limited to payments. VILLAGE OR TOWN OF THERESA - DO YOU KNOW WHERE YOU LIVE? - It has come to our attention that it's difficult for some residents to figure out if they live in the Village of Theresa or the Town of Theresa. Well, here's an easy way for you to figure it out; if your address starts with the letter "N" or "W" & you have a blue fire number/address sign on your property that says TOWN OF THERESA, you reside in the TOWN. If your address is three numbers long, followed by a street name, you reside in the VILLAGE OF THERESA. Example: 202 S. Milwaukee Street is a VILLAGE ADDRESS (the Village has one exception to this rule®). Village residents should handle their municipal business at the VILLAGE HALL at 202 S. Milwaukee Street & VOTE at the Theresa Public Library. Town residents should handle their municipal business & VOTE at the THERESA TOWN HALL located at N8679 County Hwy P or by calling the Town Clerk-Diane Steger at (920) 488-2033.
